USGA RULES GOVERN ALL PLAY EXCEPT WHERE MODIFIED BY THESE FOLLOWING LOCAL RULES

- When a player's ball has not been found or is known or virtually certain to be out of bounds, the player may proceed under local rule E-5 for a PENALTY OF TWO STROKES.
 The player may not use this option if the player has played a provisional ball or as an option to take relief for the original ball that is known or virtually certain to have come to rest in a penalty area.
- OB defined by white stakes
- Free relief from the driving range fence and netting behind 9 green.
- The course-side edge of the homeowner's wall on the left of 3 defines the OB.
- Split rail fencing defines OB on the following holes: 1, 3, 4, 8, 10, 16, 17, left and right of 1 fairway, left of 2 fairway, left of 6 tee and left of 7 fairway.
- Drop Area for holes 10 & 18 are the Red Teeing grounds, unless otherwise marked.
- The wash crossing hole 3 is a penalty area. The edge of the penalty area is as marked or defined by its natural boundary. All other washes that cross holes on 6, 11, 13, 14 & 17 are part of the general area.
- All roads and paths are considered Obstructions.
- Shots hitting telephone wires must be replayed.

- 4:15 pace of play will be enforced. Please keep pace with the group ahead of you and allow faster play through. Par 3s should be completed in 11 minutes, Par 4s should be completed in 14 minutes and Par 5s should be completed in 17 minutes.
- Please repair all pitch marks on greens, and fill divots with sand and seed provided.
- Please keep golf carts at least 30 yards from putting surfaces.
- Appropriate attire is required at all times when using any of the golf facilities.
- Please respect the privacy of homeowners and their property which borders the golf course.
- On course restrooms located at 6 green and 14 tee.
